- Scholarship recipients will be preparing for a career as a teacher at the elementary, middle school, or high school levels or as an educational administrator at any of those levels.
- Recipients should have a record of academic achievement.
- Preference should be given to students demonstrating financial need.
- Preference should be given to full time students.
- Recipients may be undergraduate or graduate students.
- Recipients will be selected by the departmental scholarship selection committee.
